

# Soy Reducer

## Description

Soy Reducer is used to lower the viscosity of your plastisol inks. Highly recommended for our new Soymax Series inks, the Soy Reducer will also perform in standard plastisol inks when needed. Gellation and fusion temperatures of the ink could change with the addition of Soy Reducer. Use of more than 10% is not recommended.

## Benefits of Soy Reducer

- Quickly reduces plastisol ink viscosity
- May be used with any One Stroke Inks plastisol
- Economically priced
- Available in quarts, gallons, and 5 gallons
- Best reducer for the new Soymax Series

## Recommendations

- Do not add more than 10% reducer to ink
- Adding more than 10% reducer may prevent ink from curing properly
- Too much reducer will alter the color of the ink
- Only reduce the amount needed for a particular print job

## Important Note

Always perform a pretest print and test cure conditions on the fabric to be printed to establish the best results. Stir inks vigorously before each use. Viscosity may need adjusting for best results.
